

CLINICAL FELLOWSHIP IN GASTROENTEROLOGY

At the University of Toronto

Applicants are invited to apply for a fully funded clinical fellowship. The program will provide advanced training in Gastroenterology, with a focus on IBD, [medical management, endoscopy (including balloon dilatation and capsule endoscopy), pathology, and clinical studies and trials]. Exposure to Pediatrics is optional. This program is for newly trained gastroenterologists who intend to open a clinical practice either in the community or in an academic setting.

The starting time of the fellowship is **negotiable**. Candidates must have completed a recognized gastroenterology training program, and must be eligible for either a general or educational license in the province of Ontario. The position is **open to both Canadian and foreign physicians**. Interested candidates should send a covering letter, updated curriculum vitae, and names and addresses of 3 referees to:
